Fire Prevention Week: As this week is Fire Prevention Week. This year's theme is "Charge into Fire Safety". This theme aims to educate people about safely using lithium-ion batteries, and emphasizes the importance of buying. charging, and recycling these batteries safely.

Lithium-Ion Battery Safety Tips for Families

A. Buy Smart

- Use trusted brands: Only purchase batteries and devices from reputable manufacturers and retailers.
- Look for certification: Check for safety certifications like UL (Underwriters Laboratories) on battery packaging.
- Avoid counterfeits: Cheap knock-offs may lack essential safety features.

B. Charge Safely

- Follow manufacturer instructions: Always use the charger that came with the device.
- Don't overcharge: Unplug devices once fully charged.
- Charge in safe areas: Avoid charging on beds, couches, or near flammable materials.
- Supervise charging: Especially for kids' devices like tablets, toys, or scooters.

C. Store Properly

- Keep batteries cool and dry: Avoid exposure to direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Don't mix old and new batteries: This can cause overheating or leakage.
- Store away from children: Keep spare batteries out of reach of young kids.

D. Recycle Responsibly

- Never throw batteries in the trash: They can cause fires in garbage trucks or landfills.
- Use local recycling programs: Find battery drop-off locations in your community.

E. Recognize Warning Signs

- Swelling, leaking, or strange smells: Stop using the battery immediately.
- Hot to the touch: Unplug and move the device to a safe area.
- Smoke or sparks: Call 911 and evacuate if necessary.
