Here are some things for you to know as we head into **Week #8** at **Prince Charles Elementary**:

1. Attendance: As we continue to nurture a positive and engaging learning environment at our school, I want to take a moment to emphasize the vital role that regular attendance plays in your child's academic success and social growth. To put it into perspective, missing just 20 days of school over the course of a year is equivalent to losing an entire month of learning.

Why Attendance Matters: Consistent attendance helps students:

Avoid falling behind in key subjects

- Stay engaged with learning and classroom activities
- Build strong relationships with peers and staff
- Develop routines that support long-term success

At the same time, we recognize that student health must come first. If your child is feeling unwell, especially with symptoms such as fever, upset stomach or a persistent cough, we ask that you keep them home to rest and recover. This helps prevent the spread of illness and ensures a healthy environment for all.
