1. **Kindergarten Registration:** Registration will commence on **Monday, January 19th**. If you have a child turning five in 2026, it's time to register for Kindergarten! Please click the link below on January 19th to complete the registration process or see Ms. Smith at the office for any assistance. 2. **District Programs:** The Lottery for District Programs will open at 8:30 am on Monday, January 26th and close at 4:00 pm on Friday, January 30th.
 - This lottery is for both District Kindergarten Programs and for Gr 6 French Immersion
 - **Nature Kindergarten is not a district Kindergarten Program***
 - The online lottery link will be posted on the District website in advance and go live at 8:30 am on January 26th.

3. **Out of School Catchment:** Royals that are Out of Catchment students, will be receiving a letter later this week as a reminder to complete the Out of Catchment form. Out of Catchment Requests may not be received prior to 8:30 am February 2nd, 2026, however the in-catchment school is able to sign the Out of Catchment form after winter break. Families must first complete registration at their catchment school. Kindergarten out-of-catchment applications will be reviewed after the first week of school in September.
4. **Signing Students In/Out:** To help us maintain accurate attendance records and ensure student safety, we ask that parents and guardians sign students in at the office if they arrive late. If your child needs to be picked up early, please also ensure you sign them out before leaving the school.

A Student Sign-In/Sign-Out Sheet is available at the office for your convenience.

5. **Parking Reminder** – The first four parking stalls as you enter the school parking lot are designated for Hand In Hand parents and staff. These stalls are clearly marked. Please ensure you do not park in these reserved spaces.
6. **Skittleball:** We are excited to announce that Skittleball season is here! This opportunity is open to all Grade 5 students. Prince Charles will be represented by two teams this year: **Prince Charles 1** and **Prince Charles 2**.
